

Experience these amazing animals up close and personal at Dolphin Cove. From swimming with the dolphins to a shark encounter, this is an experience not to be missed.

BLACK RIVER SAFARI & Y.S. FALLS TOUR

Take a boat ride amidst rare plants and wild life down the Black River. Then plunge into the cool waters at the spectacular Y.S. Falls. Talk to our Tour Desk Representative about the Appleton Rum Tour/Pelican Bar.

MAYFIELD FALLS & RAFTING COMBO

Journey through rural towns and villages to one of Jamaica’s best waterscapes. Relax under the waterfalls or soak in one of 20 natural mineral springs.

OCHO RIOS COMBO (RAFTING/DUNN’S RIVER FALLS)

Spend the day gliding gently down 3 miles of river on a 30 ft bamboo raft, take a turn on Tarzan’s swing and enjoy a dip in the water, followed by a visit to spectacular Dunn’s River Falls.

DUNN’S RIVER FALLS/DOLPHIN COVE

‘Swim with’ the dolphins, followed by a visit to Dunn’s River Falls, one of Jamaica’s national treasures.

CANOPY ZIPLINE GLIDING TOUR

Explore the rainforest, river canyon and mountains via zipline and intermittent nature walks. The highlight of the tour — the “inter-parish express” zipline — carries you at over 35 mph across 360 meters of jungle canopy.

ULTIMATE KAYAK

Ride the currents of a two-mile course down the great river and disembark on a bamboo lined riverbank. Following a short hike to the first of the three traverses, fly via zipline for 150 ft through the forest canopy. The excitement continues as you paddle your way to the swing rope or simply take a swim in the refreshing water before tackling the final cascades.

RHODES HALL HORSE BACK RIDING

Ride along the mountain trail, through the beautiful bamboo grove and pick seasonal fruits. On your return, visit the ponds, a bird and crocodile sanctuary and finally wade along the shores of Rhodes Mineral Bay.

HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

HEALTH & SAFETY

During your stay at Couples Resorts, we want to ensure your safety and well being at all times. Please be aware of the following information and health tips.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

In the case of minor illnesses or injuries, our attentive nursing staff is at hand to provide their complimentary service. Please call the front desk to be transferred. Should you require more serious medical assistance, there is also a doctor on call, at an additional cost.

SUNBATHING TIPS

We recommend avoiding direct and unprotected exposure to the sun, particularly between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm. It is advisable to always use sunscreen, preferably a waterproof brand. Dehydration can be a problem due to the intense heat at midday. This condition may be exaggerated with heavy alcohol consumption. Please drink plenty of fluids, especially water, throughout the day.

TRAVELLER’S DIARRHEA

Some guests may develop diarrhea due to changes in diet or travel to a new area. We recommend that you visit the Resident Nurse should this occur. He/She will make dietary and medication recommendations suited to your condition. Self-medication may not be the best solution, so please seek advice immediately.

INSECT BITES AND MARINE HAZARDS

While visiting a tropical country, you may be exposed to flying insects such as mosquitoes or sand flies in the mornings and at twilight. Applying insect repellent is an excellent guard against insect bites. If you step on a sea urchin or are stung by a jellyfish please visit the Nurse’s Station immediately.



EMERGENCY & DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

HURRICANE PLAN

A hurricane does not happen often in this part of the Caribbean, but meteorologists have determined that the period between June and November is when they are most likely to develop. We have taken every precaution to ensure your safety, and want to equip you with the most helpful information in the event of a hurricane.

WHAT IS A HURRICANE?

A hurricane is an intense storm with winds of over 75 miles per hour. It is usually accompanied with heavy rain, and sometimes high seas.

PHASES OF A HURRICANE

When a hurricane is in an area, there are three phases in which it is brought to our attention. These are hurricane alert, hurricane watch and hurricane warning.

HURRICANE ALERT

This means that hurricane is in the general vicinity and though it may be several hundred miles away, it is heading towards our location. During this phase, the hurricane may change course and go elsewhere. You will be advised by our General Manager and team when a hurricane alert is announced. Updates will be made available from the Front Desk.



HURRICANE WATCH

A hurricane watch is announced when a hurricane is about thirty-six hours away. Our General Manager and Couples Resorts team will make an official announcement as soon as the watch is announced. At this time you should read this brochure again and make sure that you and your spouse are briefed. It is advisable to check in with the Front Desk for the latest information. Also, ensure that your home address, telephone numbers and contacts are on file at the Front Desk.

HURRICANE WARNING

A hurricane warning is announced when a hurricane is expected to strike our location within 24 hours. You will be advised of a hurricane warning by our General Manager and team. As soon as the warning is confirmed, you should do the following:

- 1. Secure your passport and other travel documents in your room safe along with any other important papers. Make sure to put money, jewelry and other valuables in your room safe. The hotel cannot be held liable for valuables not deposited in the safe.
- 2. You may find it convenient to settle your bills at this time; it will make it much simpler and easier for you in case there are any disruptions after the hurricane. Pack a small bag with essential personal items such as medication, towels, contact lenses, toiletries, and one change of clothing.
- 3. Pack away all your clothes and non-essential personal items in your suitcases, and put the suitcases in plastic garbage bags. Housekeeping will supply these for you. Seal the plastic bags with masking tape provided, and put them in the cupboard in your room. Lock your room and take the key with you.
- 4. Go to the designated hurricane shelter as soon as you are told to do so. The hurricane shelter is located in the Executive Offices and lobby. Remain in the shelter and stay away from glass windows and doors at all times. Do not go out until you are told to do so.
- 5. Trained staff members will be assigned to help you find the shelter and manage safely during the hurricane. Please follow their instructions.



EARTHQUAKES

Earthquakes are unpredictable and strike without warning. They range in intensity from slight tremors to great shocks and may last from a few seconds to as long as five minutes. Aftershocks may come in a series over a period of several days.

In the event of an earthquake, please follow these critical action steps.

- 1. Stay calm.
- 2. Stand in a doorway or crouch under a solid desk or table away from windows or glass dividers.
- 3. Stay away from buildings, trees, telephone and electric lines.
- 4. Wear shoes and protective clothing.
- 5. Cooperate fully with any instructions from the resort’s safety team and relief organizations.
- 6. Do NOT use the telephone.
- 7. Do NOT go into damaged areas unless authorized by appropriate personnel.

FIRE PLAN

For Fires in Room

In the event of a fire in your room, please follow these critical action steps.

- 1. Stay calm.
- 2. Do NOT shout “fire”.
- 3. Call the telephone operator at extension “0” to secure help, if time allows.
- 4. If you have time, place a moist cloth over your nose and mouth to prevent the inhalation of excess smoke.
- 5. If an easy exit from the room is impeded due to the presence of heavy smoke, crawl along the floor to access an exit.
- 6. Do NOT attempt to fight the fire.
- 7. Do NOT waste time packing or unpacking anything.
- 8. Move towards your exit as quickly and as safely as possible.

For Fires Outside of Room

In the event of a fire outside your room, please follow these critical action steps

- 1. Stay calm.
- 2. Do NOT shout “fire”.
- 3. If fire or smoke is detected on your block, immediately call the telephone operator at extension “0”,and report the location you spotted the fire. If you are not in danger, pull the fire alarm located at the end of your block.
- 4. Remain in your room until a safety marshal comes to remove you.
- 5. Do NOT attempt to fight the fire.
- 6. Closely follow the instructions provided to you by the safety marshal.
- 7. Do NOT waste time packing or unpacking anything.
- 8. Do NOT make unnecessary phone calls.
- 9. Be ready to move quickly and orderly during any evacuation process.
